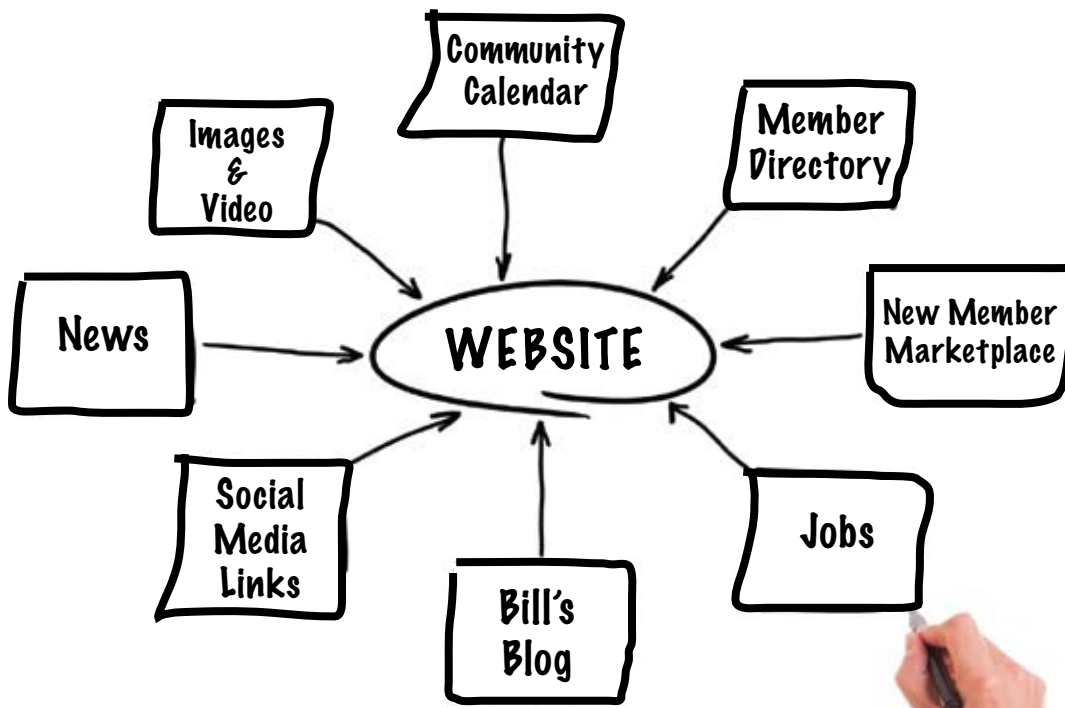

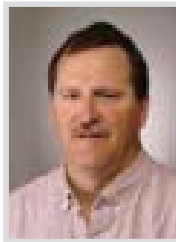
Nate Jones has been promoted to general manager of Broad Creek Marina which includes the popular Up the Creek Pub & Grill.
